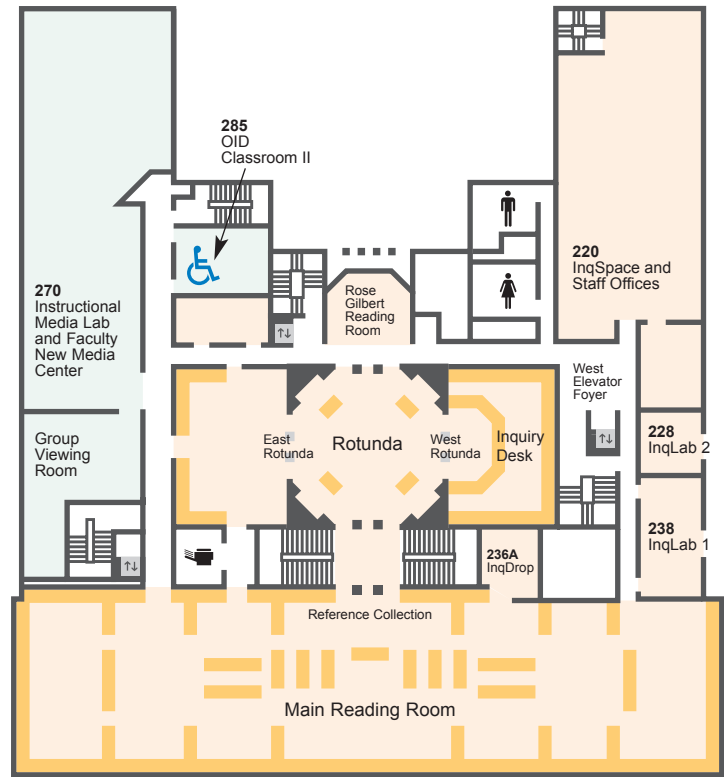
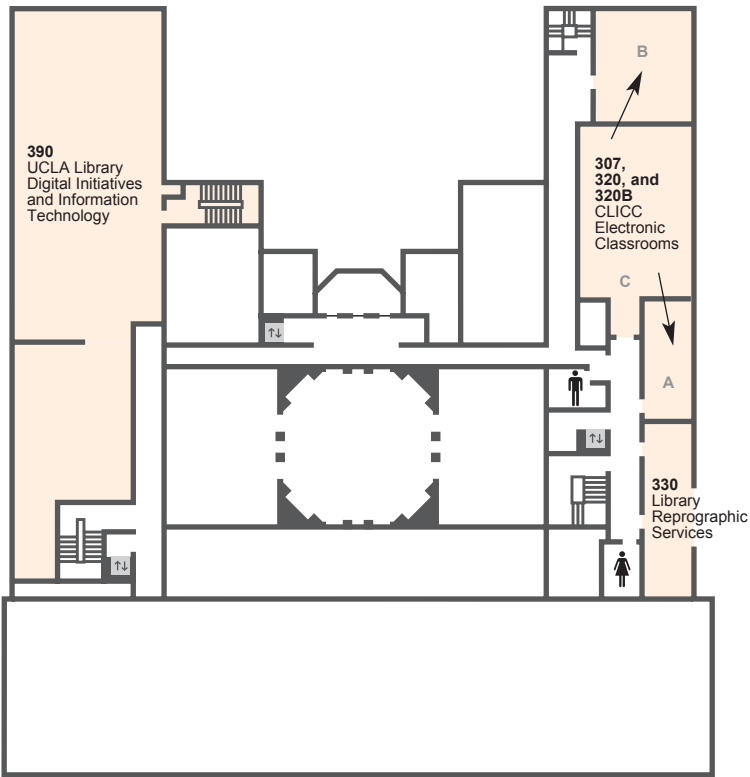

Second Floor

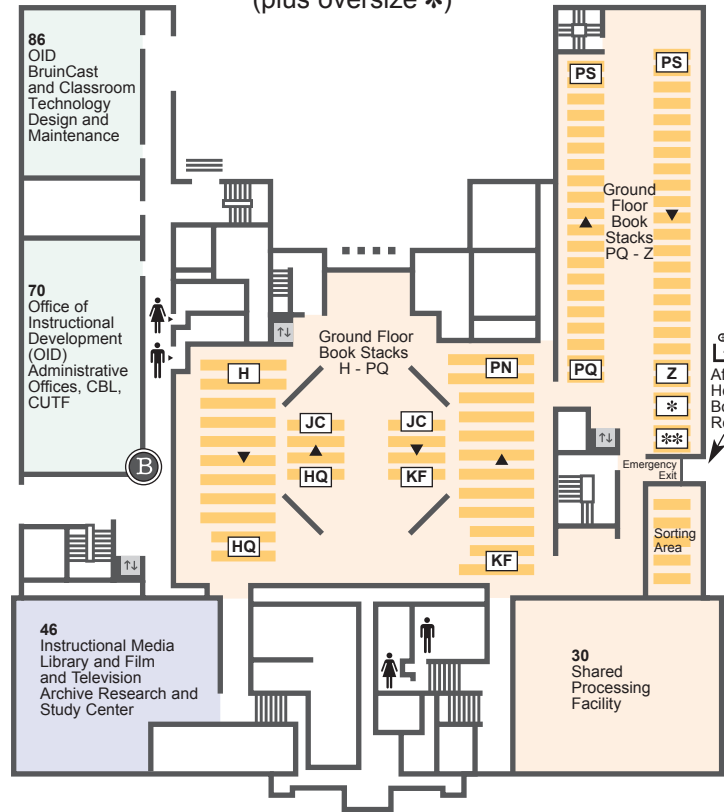


Third Floor



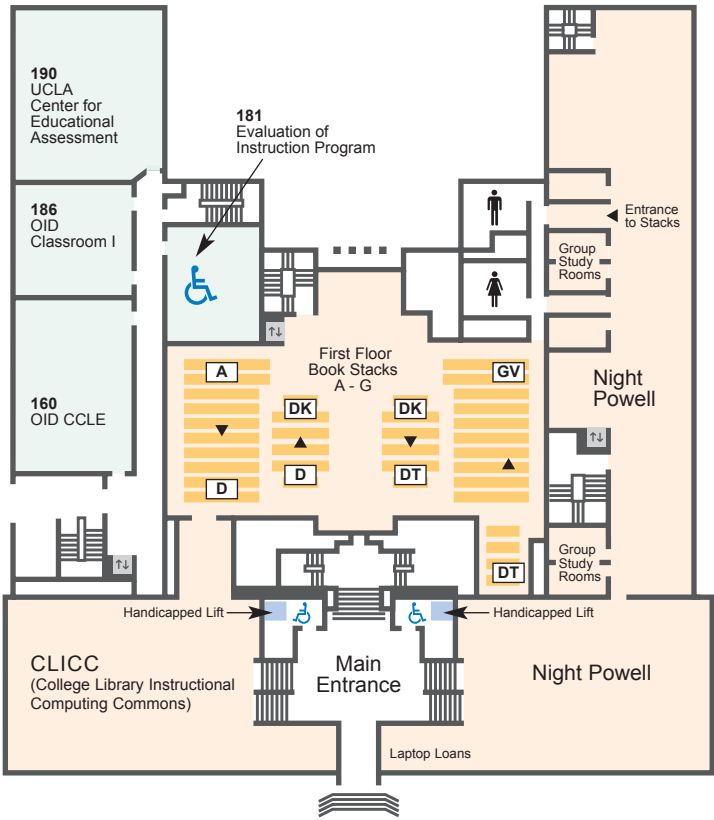

How to Read a Call Number

Read line by line:

LB

2395

.C65

1991

Read the first line in alphabetical order:
A, B, BF, C, D ... L, LA, LB, LC, M, ML ...

Read the second line as a whole number:
1, 2, 3, 45, 100, 101, 1000, 2000, 2430 ...

The third line is a combination of a letter and numbers.
Read the letter alphabetically.
Read the numbers as a decimal, e.g. .C655, C74, C8
(Some call numbers have more than one letter-number line.)

The year the book was published, in chronological order.
