Position: Up to 30 student leaders facilitating a group of 18-20 students

The purpose of Welcome Week is to help new students adjust to college life by forming supportive groups with their peers. During Welcome Week, student leaders serve as group facilitators for the program, and help incoming students make a successful transition to the academic and social climate of Adrian College.

Specific duties include:

#### Before Welcome Week

- Attend an information session with other welcome week leaders during the spring semester.
- Participate in welcome week leader training starting on Wednesday, August 10 through Saturday, August 13, 2016.

During Welcome Week (Sunday, August 14 - Sunday, August 21, 2016)

- Stay with your group during meals, evening activities, community service events, and other designated activities

- Accompany students on the incoming class trip to Chicago
- Give assistance to the program, as needed (driving vans, giving directions, and welcoming students to residence halls)
