REQUESTING FACULTY / UNIVERSITY SPEAKERS

If your group would like to request a Rice Faculty Member to participate in your event, please talk with your Office of Alumni Relations staff partner to ensure such a program would be appropriate for your group. Then, complete the Request a Speaker form (http://alumni.rice.edu/Media/Default/LearningTravel/AlumniSpeakersBureauRequestForm-Fillable.pdf) at least three months before your anticipated event date in order to ensure adequate time for coordinating with potential faculty members.

Once the Office of Alumni Relations receives your request form, it will review the request with the group to determine feasibility and ensure it is in alignment with the goals of the group and university. If it is agreed that a faculty member would be a suitable speaker for an event, the Office of Alumni Relations will contact the desired faculty member(s). If the desired faculty member(s) are interested in learning more about your event and are open to the possibility of participating, the Office of Alumni Relations will facilitate a conversation between the sponsoring group and the faculty member(s) has/have had the opportunity to connect with the sponsoring group, the faculty member will, in partnerhship with the Office of Alumni Relations, make the determination of whether or not s/he is able to participate in your event. At that point, the Office of Alumni Relations will work in partnership with the sponsoring group and faculty member(s) on all necessary arrangements, including marketing and event logistics.

In the event that the requested faculty member(s) is not available or opts not to participate, the Office of Alumni Relations may propose alternative faculty members for your consideration. Please note that requesting a faculty member does not guarantee their participation until a final confirmation is sent by the Office of Alumni Relations.
