### From the North, West, South West

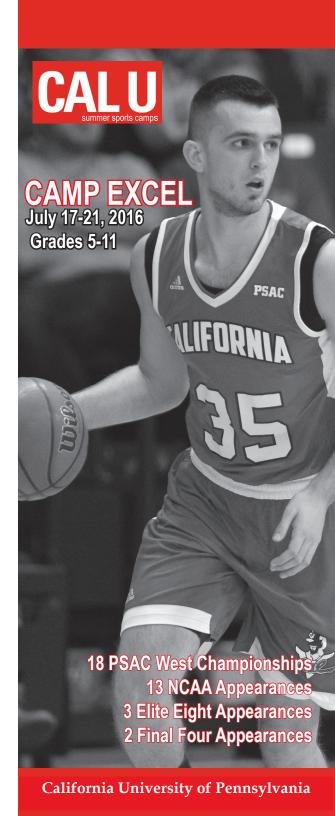
Interstate 79 South to Interstate 70 East, Interstate 70 East to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43 South).
