Scholarships are awarded to undergraduate (sophomore or higher) and graduate study and enrolled as a full time student, maintaining a grade point average of 3.0 in post secondary studies. Students studying subjects related to Finnish culture receive special consideration. Consideration is also given for demonstrated need. Individual scholarships in the past have generally been in the \$500-\$3,000 range.
