

COURSE WORK AND ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Graduate students are expected to attend all classes and to satisfactorily complete all Program requirements. In this regard, students must maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0 their graduate studies in school psychology. A grade of "C+" or lower (C, C-, F, UW, W) obtained in any graduate course in the School Psychology Curriculum is *not* acceptable. A student earning a "C+" grade or lower (C, C-,F, UW,W) must retake this course prior to graduation and earn a B- or better in order to graduate. Students are only allowed to repeat the same course once to earn a B- or better and may only repeat a maximum of two different courses. Students failing to meet these criteria will be dismissed from the program.
