

## Economic Impacts (2013)

### Agricultural and related industries generate

**13,577** jobs (19.5% of total) in Charlotte County.

**\$567.2** million in revenues.

**13.2%** contribution to gross regional product.

It is estimated that for every **\$1** invested in agricultural research and extension, there is a return of **\$20** to the community.
