## Kelly Neiber Service Project Award:

So many student councils do such awesome projects that we wanted to find a way to recognize your council for your great work. The board has created the Kelly Neiber IASC Service Project Award. This award is open to any student council in the state of Iowa who performs a service project. The best news is that there is a monetary award with this. The winning council will receive \$100 voucher for IASC activities—state conference, ILTC or adviser's conference. The deadline for submitting this project is September 6! Any project that you have completed from June 1, 2012 to June 1, 2013 is eligible. You can find more information on our website under Student Activities—Scholarships and Awards.

State conference will be Sunday, October 27 and Monday, October 28 in Des Moines at the Iowa Events Center. Students will hear A'ric Jackson from Georgia. His humorous and motivational message will keep the audience laughing, yet send them home with a memorable message. In addition, students will have the opportunity to attend three break-out sessions and network with other students. We have expanded Sunday night's offering. Rumor has it that A'ric will be preparing a Flash Mob Sunday night. After his presentation, The Media Guy will present a multi-media production entitled "Rewind." Schools may register either Sunday evening at 6:30 or Monday from 8:30 - 9:00. Schools may choose to eat lunch wherever they want.
