Diesel purifiers

Engine Control Systems diesel purifiers consist of either a ceramic (AZ series) monolith or a metallic (DZ series) monolith coated with advanced precious metal catalysts and packaged into stainless steel housings. These purifiers oxidise hazardous carbon monoxide (CO) and hydrocarbons (HC) to form harmless carbon dioxide and water. Engine Control Systems AZ diesel purifiers will also reduce total particulate emissions by typically 25%-40% by oxidising the soluble organic fraction of the particulate.

Both the AZ and DZ series purifiers are designed for ease of installation and feature quick release clamps to allow for easy removal of the catalyst centerbody for periodic inspection and baseline smoke testing.



Custom design Purimufflers™

Often standard in-line design catalysts can not be utilised due to the restrictions of space. For these applications AZ / DZ or EZ purifiers are available as custom designed units specifically tailored to suit the installation restrictions of the vehicle. Specialist custom designs are often manufactured as silencer replacement products. Selecting from an extensive CDTi database, many designs are available for present and past ranges of vehicle models.

Please consult CDTi for selection and recommendation, providing vehicle make, model and engine type details. Selection lists by vehicle make are often available – on request.



Product sizing

1. If available, use the actual engine intake air flow from the original engine manufacturer (OEM) and locate this value in the included product charts to obtain the proper product model for your engine. If you do not have the actual OEM engine intake air flow, use the general equation below to determine the approximate value. Locate this value in the appropriate product-sizing chart.

2. If your engine intake air flow value is in the range of two models of purifier, exhaust back pressure and equipment duty cycle should be used as a guide to choose the appropriate product model. In general, the larger model will provide improved carbon monoxide and hydrocarbon reductions and lower exhaust back pressure.

3. When sizing DMS and DMXS-II add-on silencers, ensure that the flange dimension (E) is the same for both the purifier and silencer. If flange dimensions (E) do not match, select an adjacent model of silencer with the correct flange size that meets exhaust friction requirements.



VE = 0.85 for normally aspirated engines
1.7 for turbocharged
2.0 for turbocharged and aftercooled

DZ diesel purifiers

The DZ series (metallic monolith), long an industry favourite, offers compact size and low exhaust back pressure. For optimum performance, we recommend that you install the DZ purifier as close to the engine exhaust manifold as possible (within 300 - 500 mm).

To further ensure low exhaust back pressure and noise, CDTi offers a complete line of low restriction DMS and DMXS-II clamp-on silencers.




DZ and EZ purifier performance

The temperature of the exhaust gases determines the degree of reduction of carbon monoxide (CO) and hydrocarbons (HC). The reduction is less when idling or at a low load and the exhaust temperature is low, than when the engine is loaded and the exhaust temperature is high.




DZ and EZ purifier light-off curves

EZ diesel purifiers

The EZ series purifier offers the same metallic substrate and catalyst as the DZ series but features all welded construction for an ultra compact size. The EZ purifier is an ideal in-line converter when retrofitting light industrial and highway vehicles where space for installation is limited.

For optimum performance, we recommend that you install the EZ purifier as close to the engine exhaust manifold as possible (within 300 - 500 mm), ahead of the vehicle's original muffler.





AZ diesel purifiers

The AZ series purifier (ceramic monolith) offers a unique zeolite washcoat base and precious metal catalyst that provides extraordinary emissions reduction performance on modern diesel engines.

The superior low temperature performance of the AZ catalyst is beneficial, especially in applications where installation 0.5 - 2m from the exhaust manifold is required.





AZ performance

The AZ purifier has been tested according to the Buscycle, Braunschweig and ISO 8178 by the Swedish Vehicles Test Authority and meets the stringent approval requirements for the Swedish market. The US EPA has also certified the AZ Purimuffler™ under the US urban bus retrofit/rebuild program.


The graph shows the reductions measured after an AZ 29 purifier has been installed on a Mercedes 814D lorry with an OM 366 engine.



AX purifiers

Model AX 230 W-AX 280 W catalyst are compact and of stainless steel all-welded construction.

The size often allows easy installation even where space is limited. The models are delivered with or without flanges for welding into exhaust systems.


AZ severe duty Purimufflers™

The AZ Severe Duty Purimuffler™ integrates an AZ catalyst and silencer in one rugged package, specially designed for use in mining and heavy industrial applications. AZ Severe Duty Purimufflers™ will afford 12-15 dB(A) sound reduction at exhaust back pressures less than 500 mm water.

The AZ Severe Duty Purimuffler™ features a double wall, heavy gauge (14 and 16 gauge), 304 series stainless steel, insulated muffler shell. The insulation serves to maximize catalyst performance while reducing muffler skin temperatures. The insulated skin also reduces heat radiation from the muffler, which can be particularly beneficial in equipment with vehicle electronic

control systems. AZ Severe Duty Purimufflers™ are available with standard slip fit inlet/outlet or with optional bolted inlet and outlet flanges.



CDTi DMS and DMXS-II add-on silencers

CDTi also offers a range of DMS and DMXS-II clamp-on silencers that can be combined readily with DZ and AZ purifiers to provide a compact purifier/silencer system with known back pressure characteristics. Both DMS and DMXS-II silencers conveniently fit between the purifier centerbody and outlet cone.

DMS silencers are designed to typically provide 10 dB(A) noise reduction. DMXS-II silencers are designed to typically provide 15 dB(A) noise reduction.

Add-on silencers are furnished with a clamp and gasket to allow combination with AZ or DZ quick release purifiers.
