# Money Management Tips

- First-time process for many students
- Spend time now to help your student prepare
- Use common sense strategies for reducing expenses
- ***Easier to reduce expenses than increase income – live frugally***



# Money Management Tips

- Avoid credit card debt
  - Frisbees/T-shirts/M&Ms
  - High Interest Rates
- Set aside funds for each semester's start-up costs
  - Books, supplies, household, entertainment
  - FA awards auto-packaged for fall/spring
  - Plan ahead if planning to enroll in at least 6 credit hours for summer 2017
- Part-time employment

  - Sign up for **GradReady**
    - A free service for UC students
    - Tools to help with paying for college, money management, and student loan repayment

# Student eBill

- ***[www.catalyst.uc.edu](http://www.catalyst.uc.edu)***
  - Student account bill online 24/7
  - Initial bill generated in early August
  - No paper bills will be sent
- Email notices sent to UConnect
  - Reminder; not needed to access bill
  - Sent prior to due dates & when bill adjusts with registration changes
- **Student ultimately responsible**
  - Work with student to print or set up 'Delegated Access'
- *Read and follow instructions*

# Student eBill Management

- Due dates important
  - Late payment fees and/or registration blocks
  - Due date for Fall 2016 to be published on [www.onestop.uc.edu](http://www.onestop.uc.edu) once determined (likely 5 days before start of term)
- eBill based on registration
  - Changing registration can change costs and aid
    - Students should be aware of 100% withdrawal deadlines
  - UC-awarded scholarships to be added by August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Transcript service indicator prevents aid from posting; final HS transcript needed by Office of Admissions
- Health Insurance
  - Automatically charged but students can waive

# Bill Payment Options

- Pay online
  - No additional charges for e-check
  - Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express
    - 2.75% non-refundable convenience fee
- Pay by mail or on-campus
  - Print billing remittance; mail with check or use drop-box
  - Do not mail or deposit cash
- Payment Plan
  - Offered and serviced by UC
  - 3 or 4 month payment options; \$35 enrollment fee
  - Plans are term-specific; annual payment plan not offered
  - Payment plan details posted at [www.onestop.uc.edu](http://www.onestop.uc.edu) once available (should be by August 1st)
    - Students will go to [www.catalyst.uc.edu](http://www.catalyst.uc.edu) to register

# UConnect Email

- ***mail.uc.edu***
- Official means for UC communications
  - UConnect account information sent to student after admission confirmation
  - Aid updates/information, eBill notices, course/grade changes, college communications
  - All UC-specific communications in one place
- Students should check daily

# Things to Consider

- Financial aid only for classes required for degree program
- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) for aid eligibility
  - Will be reviewed at least once/year
  - 3 criteria for maintaining SAP:
    - 67% completion rate
    - 2.0 GPA (after 2<sup>nd</sup> year)
    - Maximum timeframe = 1.5 times length of program
- Different enrollment requirements for different aid programs
- Be aware of drop deadlines
