Dear Mr. Henshaw,

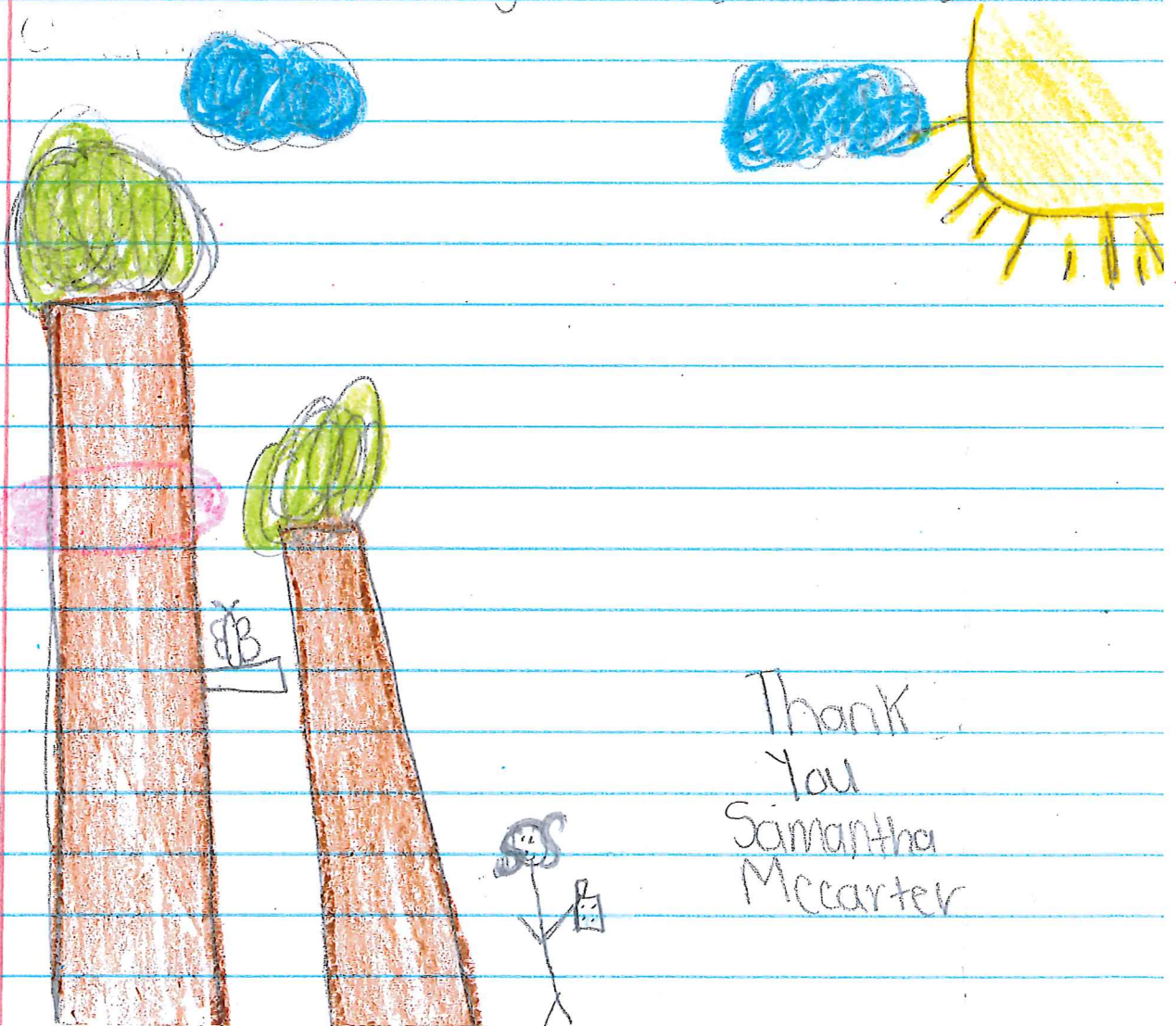

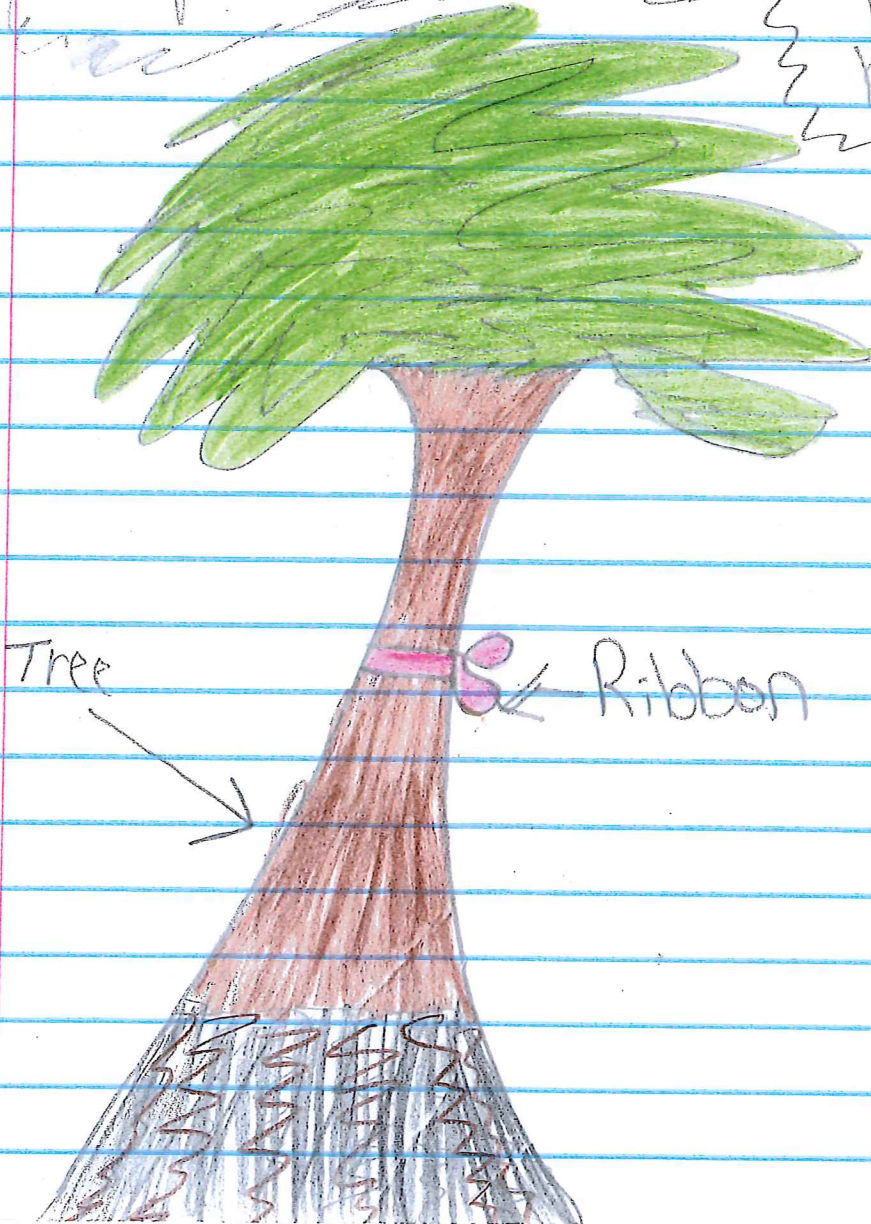
