




The number of papers published continues to grow as research programs expand worldwide.





















Looking Back: The Last Decade of Research Publishing in South Korea



2015 showed a nearly 3-fold increase in South Korean publications vs. 2005.



In 2005, South Korea published nearly equal number of papers in Medicine and Physics/Astronomy. By 2015, nearly twice as many were in Medicine.



In 2005, 4 of the top 5 journals for Korean authors were Korean. In 2015, 4 of the top 5 were International.
