Mathematica 9.0.1 Download and Installation

1. To download Mathematica 9.0.1, go to www.its.msstate.edu/software/downloads and choose the Student Use link for Mathematica. You may also access the downloads from the ITS web site at its. msstate.edu and select Downloads in the Navigation Bar.



- 2. Select the correct platform for your computer. Choose between Windows, Mac OSX, or Linux.
- 3. Click the **Download**.
- 4. You will be prompted to enter your **NetID** and **NetPassword**.
- 5. Click the click here link to download the **Mathematica installer**.


You **must register** at <u>Wolfram's website</u> to receive your activation key that will be needed after installation. Please make sure to register using your netid@msstate.edu e-mail address.



6. When the application download is complete, double click **Mathematica_9.0.1_WIN.exe** to start installation.


7. In the Wolfram Mathematica Setup window, click Next.




8. In the **Destination Location** window leave the default path and click **Next**.




9. In the **Select Components** window, click **Next**.




10. In the **Start Menu Folder** window, click **Next**.



11. In the **Ready to Install** window, click **Install**.




12. The **Mathematica** installing progress is shown.




13. In the Completing the Wolfram

Mathematica installation window, click








- 14. To activate **Mathematica**, double-click the **Mathematica icon** to launch the application.
