Installing & Registering MATHEMATICA at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs

1. Go to sitelic.colorado.edu/mathematica/ and start the registration process by using the appropriate Univ. Colorado site license #:

L3230-4152 (students only)

L2437-5121 (faculty & staff)

You will be prompted for a MathID on the second page of registration.

Assuming that YOU DON'T HAVE Mathematica on your machine, then continue as follows....

- 2. Download the Mathematica software from the sitelic.colorado.edu/mathematica/ (website). Install for a single user on personal machine. As you finish getting the software unzipped, etc., your MathID will be generated automatically --save this sequence of numbers.
- 3. Go back and finish the registration process that you already started by filling in this MathID into the appropriate field (the name of the computer is not a controlled parameter so make something up...)
- 4. Finally, a password for the registration process will be generated in an email, so, after picking the password up in email, the registration may be completed. Note: the registration window told me that the email was sent to the Colorado site license administrator, but I received the password and other data in my Inbox within a minute or so.
