






The map in Figure 1 shows the growth of Dublin.


- Examine Figure 2 on the next page, which is a table of Ireland's fastest-growing urban centres (excluding Dublin).

- (b) With reference to **one** Irish urban centre that you have studied, explain the factors that led to its development. Use the headings shown in the answer spaces given.


