

Summary (Cheat Sheet) of CSS Part 1: Basics

1. *Use an external style sheet (We will do it this way)

```
<link rel="stylesheet" href="styles/main.css">
```

2. Embed the styles in the head section

```
<style>
  body {
    font-family: Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif;
    font-size: 87.5%; }
  h1 { font-size: 250%; }
</style>
```

3. Use the style attribute to apply styles to a single element

```
<h1 style="font-size: 500%; color: red;">
  Valley Town Hall</h1>
```

Symbol	Name	Type	Description
px	pixel	absolute	A single dot on a monitor. The number of dots per inch depends on the resolution of the monitor.
pt	point	absolute	A point is 1/72 of an inch.
em	ems	relative	One em is equal to the font size for the current font.
%	percent	relative	A percent specifies a value relative to the current value.

For font size it is better to use relative measurements rather than absolute.

Example: Usually screen sizes have a default font-size of 16px. Setting it to 87.5% would be 14px. Using 2ems later for margin would be 28 (2*14). .75em would be 10.5px (.75*14)

Attribute Selectors:

Three ways to select elements:

- **type:**
 - HTML: <p>
 - CSS: p{ .. }
- **id:** unique label assigned to an element Ex.
 - HTML: <p id="main">
 - CSS: #main{..}
- **class:** label assigned to multiple elements
 - HTML: <p class="mytext">
 - CSS: .mytext{..}

Universal Selector *{..} (Applies to everything on page)

Block Level Elements: Start with newline Ex. <p> <h1>

Inline Level Elements: Without a newline Ex.

<div> - block element

 - inline element

No meaning. Used with CSS. <div> can set style attributes to large blocks of content and the element can set style attributes to parts of the text.

Example:

```
<div id="main">
    <h1 class="base_color">Materials</h1>
    <p>Links for the downloads:</p>
    <ul>
        <li><a href="quizzes.html">Quizzes</a></li>
        <li><a href="exams.html">Exams</a></li>
    </ul>
    <p id="copyright" class="base_color">Adler
    Incorporated</p>
</div>
```
