Student Visa Requirement	F-1 visa, W&J will issue form I-20 and provide guidance on applying for the appropriate visa. <small>*Students must depart the US within 15 days of official end date at W&J per US government Regulations</small>	
Student Health Insurance	All exchange students are required to purchase W&J health insurance for the duration of their stay. Calendar year students are also required to be insured over the summer.

Cumulative GPA	We do not require a specific GPA. The student should be in good academic standing with their home institution and be formally nominated by their international office.
