

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
FLORIDA GULF COAST UNIVERSITY, FT. MYERS, FLORIDA
and
PALM BEACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE, PALM BEACH, FLORIDA

The intent of this Agreement is to facilitate the smooth transfer and transition of Associate of Science ("AS") degree graduates from the Criminal Justice Program at Palm Beach Community College ("PBCC") into Florida Gulf Coast University ("FGCU") Bachelor of Science ("BS") degree program in Criminal Justice.

Before being accepted into FGCU, the student must have received an A.S. degree from PBCC, consisting of the 64 credit hours as outlined in Appendix A. Students will complete the PBCC General Education requirements, which include 36 credit hours in the areas of communication, mathematics, social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences. PBCC will certify on the official transcript that the student has satisfactorily completed PBCC General Education core curriculum. PBCC students who enter FGCU through this articulation agreement will enter FGCU as Juniors. Through this agreement, PBCC students may complete and may transfer up to a maximum of 72 credit hours of lower division credit from PBCC to FGCU.

A minimum grade point average of 2.0 is required for acceptance into FGCU. Once accepted at FGCU, the student will need to successfully complete 48 credit hours of upper division credits (3000 level or above) at FGCU as specified in Appendix A. Students remain subject to all other state and FGCU admission requirements as specified in the FGCU catalog.

This Agreement will be in force for the 2001-02 FGCU academic year and for each successive academic year, unless canceled by either institution. Program changes by either institution can be incorporated into this Agreement by written amendment, as agreed by both parties. If this Agreement is canceled, it will not affect students enrolled in and accepted in the FGCU programs at the time of cancellation.
