The Council of Science Editors (CSE) offers <a href="three">three</a> systems of documentation: 1) citation-name, 2) citation-sequence, and 3) name-year. This document focuses on the third: name-year. In the name-year system, you should list (but do not number) your sources alphabetically in the reference list at the end of your paper. In the sentences of your paper, cite your sources by giving the author's last name and year of publication in parentheses.
