IMPORTANT/URGENT

All Deans of the Faculties/ D.S.W. / All Provosts Hall of Residence/NRSC, All Principals of Colleges/Polytechnics/ Schools/All Chairmen, Department of Studies, Coordinator CPC/BE (Evening)/ Biotechnology Units.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated 08.05.2009 Civil Appeal No. (887/2009) has completely banned Ragging in educational institutions and the U.G.C., on the directives of the Supreme Court framed guidelines for curbing the menace of ragging in the Universities/ Educational Institutions. It is completely banned and being treated as a punishable offence and no one is allowed to go against the order of the Hon'ble Supreme court

The University in pursuance of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Guidelines of the UGC vide letter No. F. 1-15/2009/(ARC) dated 25th. Feb, 2016 considers Ragging an act of punishable charge as per existing Laws and as per rules prescribed in the AMU Students' Conduct & Discipline Rules, 1985, which may include suspension or even expulsion of the student from the rolls of the University.

It is therefore, requested to kindly make the students fully aware of this fact by displaying notices at the appropriate places and take preventive measures by forming "Anti-Ragging Committees/Anti-Ragging Squad" consisting of teachers and few senior students. It is, further requested that names of committee members alongwith their mobile number and Email ID may be displayed on notice boards for access of students. The members of the constituted committee may be asked to remain extra vigilant to keep watch on the students in their respective Departments. A copy (hard & soft) of the notification of Anti-Ragging Committee/Anti-Ragging Squad may kindly be sent to the office of the undersigned.

The Dean, Students' Welfare is requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committees and anti-ragging squads, setting up of Anti-ragging Cell, installing CCTV Cameras at vital points, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers, mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured.

All the Chairmen/Head of the Departments are requested to hold the workshops, seminars on eradication of ragging from AMU-Campus and are requested to display Anti Ragging Posters at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteens, riails of residence and Common places etc.

The Proctorial team will inspect the places such as hostels, students in the Departments, Canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, and any other measure which would augur well in preventing ragging and any uncalled for behavior/incident shall be seriously undertaken. The Dean, Students' Welfare (DSW) may be made aware of the anti-ragging helpline, anti-ragging website, anti-ragging monitoring agency to the students and parents/guardians and community.
