# Coaching Certification - Original and Second Pathway Comparison

Effective immediately, coaches looking to obtain New York State certification have the option of pursuing a second pathway to complete the required coaching coursework via online courses offered by the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS).

## 1<sup>st</sup> Renewal (second-year)

- CPR/First Aid
- Child Abuse workshop

The pathway chosen at the time of their **2<sup>nd</sup> Renewal** locks the coach into a set of certification requirements that will need to be met for subsequent TCL renewals, as well as their eventual professional coaching certificate.

- All items required for initial TCL and first renewal
