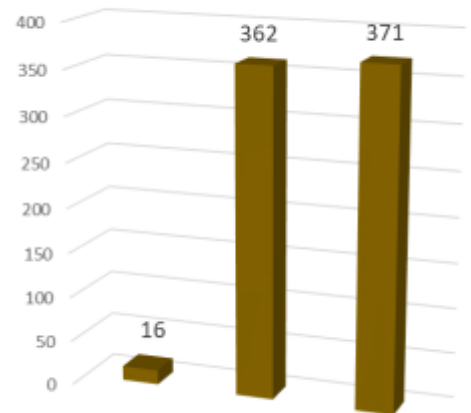

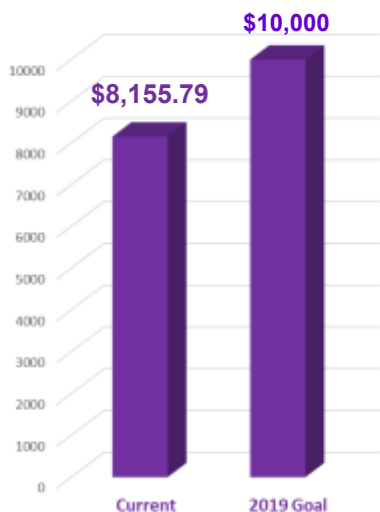


CHEA Purple Pig
