Know Learn Connect Reflective Activity

The Purpose	Possible Strategies
Know To identify what your students know about a course topic, concept, etcprior to instruction.	• Prior to completing course readings & activities, prompt students to compose a reflection on what they already specifically know about a course topic or concept.
Learn Each student identifies and/or recognizes what he or she learned after instruction and the completion of course activities.	• After completing course readings & activities, each student composes 3-5 summative sentences reflecting upon what he or she learned about the course topic or concept.
Connect To identify how each student connects with the course topic or a few of the concepts covered during instruction.	• Each student selects two concepts from the course topic and identifies how he or she personally connects with his or her selected concepts based on personal experience, past knowledge, and or a real world event.
