

## **Grand Wailea Foundation launches to serve Maui County**

The island's largest private employer extends its legacy of giving with a lead gift from owner BRE Hotels & Resorts and a guest contribution program

WAILEA, Hawai'i (November 18, 2019) — Today, BRE Hotels & Resorts, owner of Grand Wailea Maui, Ritz-Carlton Kapalua, and Turtle Bay Resort, announced the launch of the Grand Wailea Foundation. Initial gifts to area nonprofits and organizations will be awarded by the Grand Wailea Foundation on December 1 at the resort's annual Tree Lighting event. In addition to BRE Hotels & Resorts' \$75,000 lead gift, the Foundation will be supported through optional contributions by guests at Grand Wailea and fundraising events planned in its inaugural year.
