Registration & Fees

Once families register for Summer School, they will get a confirmation email with a link to register for Summer Spectacular programming. Please click on that link and follow the steps to register for after summer school programming. If you would like to register for Summer Spectacular programming but **do not** want to register for Summer School, please visit www.rusd.org/district/summer-school and fill out the registration form.

There are fees associated with Summer Spectacular. Fees must be paid online at time of registration or brought to the Extended Learning Office at 3109 Mt. Pleasant St., building #1. A student is not considered enrolled in Summer Spectacular until both online registration and fees are complete and confirmation has been received by parent/guardian by email or mail.

Fees are based on a student's lunch status (students outside of the District are considered full status) and will cover the full 6-weeks of programming. Please note, some field trips may cost extra (information and permission forms will be sent home ahead of time).

Elementary students in grades 4K-5 will rotate the following classes daily available at all sites!

Mindworks Global Treasures

Students will explore weekly sport themes including kickball, flag football, soccer, camping games and backyard games of the past. Students will be outside, weather permitting.














Camp Explore at Schulte Elementary School Offered 1:00-4:30pm, Monday-Thursday immediately after summer school, following the RUSD summer school calendar!
