Diapers	Bagged	Curbside in trash cart
Fats, cooking oils, or grease	Sealed container	DPW Recycling Facility or curbside in trash cart
Food and Pet Waste	Bagged	Curbside in trash cart
Pizza boxes	As is	Curbside in trash cart

Recyclables		
Cans	Loose, no food residue	Curbside in recycling cart
Cardboard Boxes	Flattened	Curbside in recycling cart
Fluorescent light bulbs	As is	Corvias Community Centers or DPW Recycling Facility
Papers (e.g. magazines, office paper, newspapers, junk mail)	As is, no food residue	Curbside in recycling cart
Plastic Bottles #1-7	Loose, no food residue	Curbside in recycling cart

Bulk Trash		
Bulk Trash (e.g. furniture, appliances, mattresses, bikes)	As is	Curbside, bulk trash
Yard waste (e.g. grass clippings, leaves)	Bagged in clear plastic bags	Curbside next to trash cart

Hazardous Waste		
Electronics (e.g. computer monitors, CPUs, laptops, printers, TVs, CDs)	Sealed, labeled container	DPW Hazardous Waste Facility
Household Cleaners	Sealed, labeled container	DPW Hazardous Waste Facility or Corvias Warehouse
Oil (e.g. motor oil, gasoline)	Sealed, labeled container	DPW Hazardous Waste Facility or Corvias Warehouse

DPW Hazardous Waste & Recycling Facility is located behind building 3-1137 on Reilly Road. DPW is open Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

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Corvias Maintenance Warehouse is located at Bldg. # 6-9357 near the corner of Honeycutt Road and South Lucas Drive. Corvias Warehouse is open Friday from 2 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.
