Clip a Rhyme

Print off onto cardstock, cut apart into strips like the example below & laminate for durability.



Directions: Child identifies the first picture, names the other pictures, then uses a clothespin to clip the one picture that rhymes with the first one. (Example above: *bee*- child would clip *tree*). Great for fine motor!






- Rhyming Memory Match

- Have fun and create your own rhyming games!
























Directions:
