

Campaigns tactics being creative


Whatever tactics you decide to use its important to think creatively.

Campaigning should be fun for you and the people you get involved.




Example: Stopping the shark cull

These campaigns began in response to the Western Australian government plans to catch and kill any shark 3m or over that comes within 1km of a Perth beach.







Example: 'Sleep with the right people'

- Part of a wider campaign which calls to boycott a number of hotels who have poor working conditions for their lowest paid workers.
- 'Sleep with the right people' is a sub-campaign organised by members of the LGBT community to support the wider campaign.
