

Buffer a single parcel and get a list of names and addresses within a given number of feet from your parcel:

Go to www.hcpafl.org.

Mouse over SEARCH, click **Search GIS/Maps**. You **must** start your search from GIS/Maps. Do **not** go through the Property Search or Search Real Estate options.

Pop-up blocker must be turned off for this website (see the end of this document for more information).

Click Proceed to Web site to accept the disclaimer.

On the upper right hand side click the radio button next to the type of search you want to do. (Here I'm doing a FOLIO number search.) And type in the appropriate information.




Click the IDENTIFY tab to close the Identify window:



Click the Buffer Tool button:




Enter the distance in feet and click the Buffer button:


To Turn off Pop-Up Blocker:

Internet Explorer


Open Internet Explorer




Select the Tools button



Select Internet options



On the Privacy tab, uncheck the box next to Turn on Pop-up Blocker and click OK.




Google Chrome

If you see a spreadsheet symbol with a red X (see below):



this means Google chrome has blocked the download.

Click on that spreadsheet symbol with the red X. A list of blocked content appears. Click the box to **Always allow pop-ups from <http://gis.hcpafl.org>**. Click Done.



Click on the Export type to download, again. The file will be downloaded to your Downloads folder.

Another way to allow downloads in Chrome:

Allow or block content settings for certain sites

You can set exceptions to your content settings (like plugins, JavaScript, and notifications) for specific websites. Learn more about [changing your content settings](#).

Without changing your default settings, you can add an exception to the default for a specific website or domain. For example, by default, Chrome allows cookies to save local data from sites. But if you don't trust a site, you can add an exception to block cookies on only that site.

To add an exception to your content settings, follow these steps:

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More \ddots > **Settings**.
3. At the bottom, click **Show advanced settings**.
4. Under "Privacy," click **Content settings**.
5. Under the type of content or permission that you want to update, click **Manage exceptions**.
6. Under "Hostname pattern," enter the web address that you want to create an exception for.
 - To create exceptions for an entire domain, insert [*.] before the domain name. For example, [*.]google.com will match drive.google.com and calendar.google.com.
 - You can also specify an IP address, an IPv6 address, or a non-http URL.
7. Under "Behavior," select **Allow** or **Block**.

You can also remove exceptions you don't want any more. Point to the site or domain, and then click Remove \times > **Done**.
