Dear Susquenita High School Families,

As mentioned in yesterday's correspondence, Susquenita High School had proactively shifted to remote learning for Friday, March 12, 2021, due to the number of COVID cases in the 14-day rolling period beginning to approach the maximum case threshold. This was not a mandated closure.

However, late yesterday, members of the Joint Rapid Response Team shared with us additional information which has caused us to revise our *proactive* closure to a *mandated* closure of the high school building.

This mandated closure now requires the District to pause high school athletic and extracurricular activities.

In-person instruction and all activities will resume on Monday, March 15, 2021.
