Dear Mr. Herrera:

As mentioned in my voicemail today, the Vermont Attorney General's Office has received your request for public records. You requested:

Good afternoon, the owner of the tag # [REDACTED] from Vermont, Christopher A. Rogers, claiming to be the owner of a company based in Delaware got \$50,000 from my son as investment of such company. He signed a document transferring 13% of the stock to my son only to disappear a few months later. I'm trying to track this individual to bring him to justice. I'm respectfully asking you to provide any public information on this individual to provide to authorities. If there are any fees I need to pay for such records please let me know how to pay them. Thank you for your attention to this very important matter for me.

As a general matter, if you suspect a crime has been committed, you should contact local law enforcement.

Regarding your request for public records, it would be helpful to hear which specific records you are seeking. To clarify, we are only able to provide records for which we are custodian.
