Sports Medicine Board Certification Examination

1. Details of the Board Certification

- a. WEBSITE : www.abp.org
- b. Exam is administered through American Board of Family Medicine:
www.abfm.org (Applicant will be given a temporary ABFM ID to register for test)
- c. Prerequisites for Pediatric Sports Medicine Subspecialty exam / CAQ:
 - i. <https://abp.org/content/sports-medicine-certification>
 - ii. Initial certification in General Pediatrics (with appropriate MOC)
 - iii. **COMPLETED** 1 year of training in ACGME accredited Primary Care Sports Medicine fellowship (Verification of training is required)
 - iv. Valid license
- d. Dates: Sports Medicine CAQ Exam is given *one time per year* in **July**. See ABP website for exact dates.
 - i. <https://abp.org/content/exam-dates-and-fees-subspecialties>
 - ii. Registration: **Feb/March**
 - iii. Late registration: **April**
- e. Costs:
 - i. Regular registration \$2,900, Late registration \$3,245
 - ii. Recertification registration \$1,300, Late registration \$1500
- f. Format: 200 multiple choice questions, administered at certified testing facility (Available in all states)
- g. Results: Available 6-8 wks following test. Candidates will be emailed when test scores are available. Results are found in candidate's ABP portfolio.

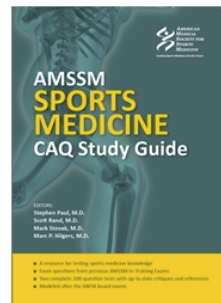
