



## **Guidelines for Risk Stratification\***

- Chronic mental or physical disease with low impact on risk for hospitalization
- Safe and stable home environment
- Patient engaged in care
- Recent hospitalization, especially for poorly controlled chronic conditions
- Active substance abuse
- Immunocompromised
- Unsafe living situation for social or environmental reasons
- Non-responsive to attempts to contact
- History of hospitalization for poorly controlled chronic condition
- Minimal family or outside support
- Sporadically engaged in care

<sup>\*</sup>Reassess every six monthsor after hospital admission or significant change in status
